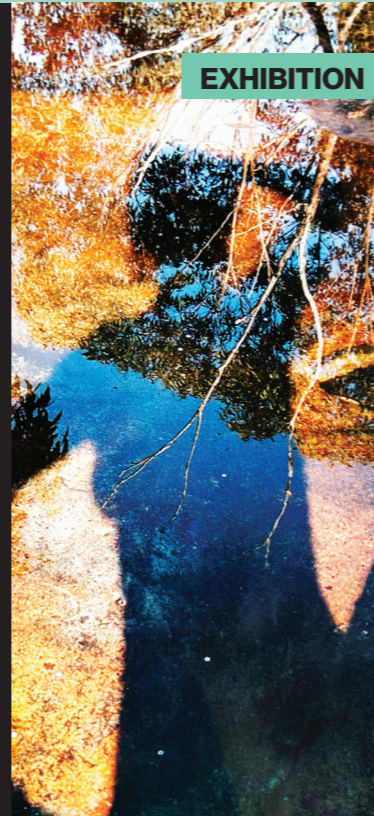
Non-binary, Asexual, Biracial AND Neurodivergent? Utter Mess!

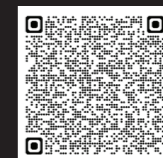
