## RE: Road Access Information following the Mount Dandenong Severe Weather Event

On 9-10 June 2021, Victoria experienced a severe weather event with strong winds and heavy rain. The Dandenong Ranges area saw significant damage to roads and power infrastructure due to the high volume and size of the trees felled by the storm.

5 arterial roads in the Mount Dandenong area impacted by storm damage have been subject to access restrictions since June 9, restricting access to local traffic, emergency crews and permitted vehicles only.
