For this activity you will need:

- Paper
- Textas/pencils
- Photos (optional)
- Pictures from the local paper or magazines (optional)



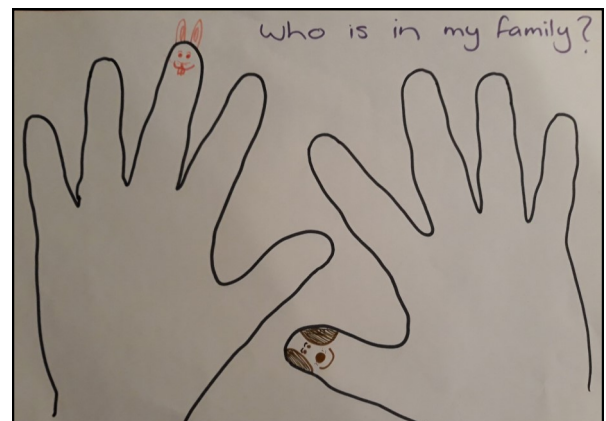
What is the learning in this activity?

Ages: For ages 4 & up

Purpose: This is a fun activity to help children explore their families, neighbourhoods and communities. It helps children identify their own supports and helpers in the community.

Lets do

1. Trace around your hand/s. Use this as the template for drawing onto - each finger will represent a person. Their face or name can be added to the drawing.
2. Talk to your child about the different people in their family/school/neighbourhood, and what each of them do.
3. Ask your child to draw each person onto the fingers and help them to add any words or other details they'd like to include.
4. Reflect together on these people and how they fit into your child's world.
