

Threading

For this activity you will need:

- Cardboard
- Pen
- Scissors
- Wool or shoe lace
- Hole puncher



What is the learning in this activity?

Ages: Age 3-5

Purpose: Creative fun activity supports fine motor development and eye hand coordination. Talking about the characters your child creates provides an opportunity to reflect on the feelings and experiences of others - which supports social and emotional development.

Let's play!

- 1. Draw a person, animal or shape onto the cardboard.
- 2. Using scissors cut the person, animal or shape out.
- 3. Use the hole puncher to create holes around the shape.
- 4. Using the wool or shoe lace thread through the holes.









Let's talk..

Qs - What animal will you draw? Does your person have a name? How is your animal or person feeling today? Tell me more..?

Extension - Coloured shapes could be cut out and holes punched into them and these could be sewn onto the person, animal or shape. A face could be drawn onto the person to reflect the feelings you and I your child have discussed.
