## Grants for Community

Yarra Ranges Council's Grants for Community Program supports community-based projects that build the social and cultural life of the region.

Grants are available for eligible not-for-profit community groups and creatives in three funding streams: Arts & Heritage; Festivals & Events; Community Development. Projects which build mental and physical health and wellbeing, support strong and sustainable community connections and nurture thriving local places, will be prioritised.

**Program pool:** \$500,000

**Grants amount:** \$10,000

**Opens:** 1 June, 2022

**Closes:** 15 July 2022

**Announcement:** October 2022

**Commences:** 1 January 2023

**Frequency:** Annual

## Capital Development Grant

Capital development grants offer financial assistance to improve sport and active recreation infrastructure.

Funding is provided as a one off grant with the goal of benefiting sporting and recreation groups as well as the general community.

A capital development grant can cover up to 50% of the total project cost but not exceeding \$30,000. Not-for-profit sporting or active recreation organisations that have a current lease/license or tenancy agreement with Yarra Ranges Council or recognised government body (eg. Parks Vic/DELWP) are eligible to apply.

**Grants amount:** \$30,000 with 50% co-contribution

**Opens:** 13 June 2022

**Closes:** 24 July 2022

**Announcement:** September 2022

**Commences:** October 2022

**Frequency:** Annual

## Small Grants

Small Grants can support not-for-profit groups with opportunities and challenges in their communities. Eligible community groups and individuals can apply once in a financial year for projects meeting the criteria and eligibility requirements (this enables fair access across groups and organisations in Yarra Ranges).

Applications that promote a healthy and connected community and social inclusion will be considered across the following categories:

- Connected and vibrant communities (up to \$1000)
- Community planning (up to \$1000)
- Youth pathways (up to \$250)
- Sports participation: Individual (up to \$250), Teams and Incorporated Sports Club (up to \$500)
- Economic Development (Up to \$1,000)
- Community relief and recovery (Covid 19, 2021 storm, other emergencies) (Up to \$1000)
- In-kind support for halls and facilities (up to \$300)
- In-kind support for waste management (up to 30 bins)

**Program pool:** \$100,000

**Grants amount:** From \$250 to \$1,000

**Opens:** First of each month

**Closes:** Last day of each month

**Announcement:** Four weeks after closing date

**Commences:** After funding awarded

**Frequency:** Monthly (except June & December)
